

# BEHIND THE SCENES

Since June 2015, The Moving Architects has delivered the readily downloadable interview-style podcast **Movers & Shapers: A Dance Podcast**. Hosted by Artistic Director of The Moving Architects Erin Carlisle Norton, the podcast features biographical interviews with those who “shape” the dance field, including choreographers, dancers, arts administrators, dance writers, creative collaborators, and dance educators. The podcast is a project of the NJ/NYC-based dance company The Moving Architects, a dance organization known for powerful female-centric performances, collaborative projects, dance podcasts, and accessible movement education.



# ABOUT ERIN

Host Erin Carlisle Norton brings to the podcast over two decades of professional experience in the dance field as a dancer, choreographer, arts administrator, dance scholar, and dance educator. As Artistic Director of The Moving Architects, she has taught and led creative performance projects internationally, nationally, and regionally, active in both the NJ and NYC dance communities. With this background, Erin guides podcast guests through interviews with a refreshing blend of authenticity, enthusiasm, and insight, creating space for podcast guests to openly share their personal stories and experiences with listeners.

# FEATURED ARTISTS

Movers & Shapers' rich history of 130+ interviews features a wide-range of “shapers” in the dance field. From **dance legends** such as Douglas Dunn (Judson Church) and Moses Pendleton (Momix); to current **cutting-edge innovators** such as Rosie Herrera (choreographer) and Melanie George (dramaturg); to **niche artists** like Preeti Vasudevan (classical Indian dance) and Naomi Goldberg Haas (Dances For A Variable Population); to **changemaker administrators** like Duke Dang (Guggenheim) and Alejandra Duque Cifuentes (Dance/NYC); **dance educators** Deborah Damast (NYU Steinhardt), and Zvi Gotheimer (Artistic Director/Educator); and **dance writers** Jennifer Stahl (Editor-in-Chief Dance Magazine) and Wendy Perron (dance writer), the podcast features well-known and lesser-known individuals each making deep impacts in their communities with fascinating stories to share.

## INTERVIEW PARTNERSHIP

Erin Carlisle Norton expertly leads the podcast guest through an autobiographical series of questions that promise intriguing dialogue while discussing first introductions to dance, personal life, struggles, successes, and dreams. All interviews are recorded virtually through a podcast interview platform and edited for flow with links to content available on the podcast "Show Notes" pages on The Moving Architects website.
